# Late Effects of Polio

The late effects of polio are a resurgence of physical symptoms 15 years or more after the initial polio infection. The late effects of polio can refer to any of the following symptoms:

- new muscle weakness and wastage
- increased fatigue
- pain
- breathing, sleep and swallowing problems

There are many symptoms associated with the late effects of polio. Each polio survivor will have their own unique set. Most symptoms can be reduced if properly assessed and managed.
